- WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1040-ML(-18, Section 4, the Commissioner of Education has the authority to manage the day-to-day administrative activities of Nay-Ah-Shing School; and
- WHEREAS, the School Board for Nay-Ah-Shing School has not been confirmed by the Band Assembly for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and
- WHEREAS, said School Board has the authority under Band Statute 1040-ML(-18, Section 244) & {7} to adopt policies to regulate pupil and employee behavior; and,
- WHEREAS, the Nay-Ah-Shing School has officially opened a new school year on September 1, 1983 with such necessary policies to be in force.
- NOW THEREFORE, I, Lon Burn, under the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1040-MLC-18, Section 4 for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, do hereby order implementation of "Nay-Ah-Shing School Staff and Student Policy" Handbook incorporated by referenced attachment until such time as the School Board exercises their legal authority in this matter.
