Commissioner's Order 01-99

A COMMISSIONER'S ORDER REQUIRING THAT ALL FUNDS RECEIVED ON BEHALF OF THE MILLE LACS BAND BE DEPOSITED WITH THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET WITHIN TEN WORKING DAYS OF THEIR RECEIPT.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to 22 MLBSA section 104 (a) and (b), the Commissioner of Finance is chief administrative officer of the Office of Management and Budget exercising general supervision of the Office; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to 22 MLBSA section 104 (f), the Commissioner of Finance has the power to require persons under the jurisdiction of the Band to report information as to the collection of taxes, fees received from licenses, and revenue from other sources, and such other information as may be needed in performance of official duty, and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to 22 MLBSA section 104 (m), the Commissioner of Finance shall have the power to promulgate rules and regulations through Commissioner's Order for the administration and enforcement of the provisions of said title.

NOW THEREFORE, It is now ordered that all funds received on behalf of the Mille Lacs Band shall be deposited with the Office of Management and Budget within ten working days of receipt.
