Commissioner's Order 11-94

Commissioner's Order condemning and ordering the vacating of a residence that is creating a public health hazard for the people of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 8.08, the Commissioner of Health and Human Services has the authority to issue Commissioner's Orders as is deemed necessary for the public health of Band members, and;

whereas, due to the lack of water, sewer, electricity, heat and dilapidated condition of the old Loretta Smith house (#33) located just east of the water tower in District One, Vineland area, an unsafe, unhealthy and hazardous environment exists for Mille Lacs Band members, and;

WHEREAS, the house of Loretta Smith (#33) was condemned by the Mille Lacs Band Housing Authority in February of 1993 and Loretta Smith signed a letter relinquishing her legal holdings in the house on March 3, 1994 and acknowledges that it is in the communities best interest to demolish the building for health and safety reasons and she no longer resides there.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordered that the old Loretta Smith house (#33) is condemned and it is further ordered that the building is to be vacated within (5) days of the posting of this order so that the house may be demolished.
