- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa desires to provide for these services under the authority of P.L. 93.638 contract with Indian Health Service.
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Board has been conferred subject-matter jurisdiction to authorize the preparation of proposals and to negotiate all grants and contracts on behalf of the Band pursuant to Board Statute #1032-MLC-1, Section 21.
- NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Board Statute #1032-MLC-1, Section 27, I, Joseph Nayquonabe do hereby approve the submittal of a P.L. 93-638 contract proposal to Indian Health Service to carry out the proposal project during the 12-month period beginning October 1, 1986, and ending September 30, 1987.
