

Commissioner's Order 04-83

Human Services

A Commissioner's Order to cease operations for the Human Services structure of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly failed to meet for the purposes of appropriation for governmental and programmatic funds for fiscal year 1984; and,


WHEREAS, Band law requires that District I, II, and III Representatives be present to form a quorum for the Band Assembly to meet; and,

WHEREAS, the absence of the District II Representative has prohibited the Band Assembly from conducting any official acts of government, including a Resolution which would permit the continuing operation of programs.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 103E-MLC-1, Section 27, I, Joseph Nayquonabe, Commissioner of Human Services hereby order and decree that all programmatic activities cease to operate on September 30, 1983 at 12:00 midnight.

This Commissioner's Order is effective until superceded by an Executive Order or enactment of the Band Assembly.
