

Commissioner's Order 14-87

A Commissioner's Order authorizing the disposal of ill animals that may threaten Band members and other animals.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 7, the Commissioner of Human Services has the authority to take such measures as are necessary to prevent any actions which threaten the well-being of Band members; and,

WHEREAS, several complaints have been made of diseased dogs being a threat to Band members and pets;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Joseph Nayquonabe, under the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 7.02, for the non-removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, do hereby declare these animals to be a threat to the health and safety of the Band, and order these animals to be disposed of in a humane manner.
