

Commissioner's Order 10-86

Human Services

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa is authorized to contract with Federal, State and local governments for programs and services benefitting members of the reservation; and,

WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has funds available to provide for medical and dental services; and,

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa desires to provide for these services under the authority of P.L. 93.638 contract with Indian Health Service.

WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Board has been conferred subject-matter jurisdiction to authorize the preparation of proposals and to negotiate all grants and contracts on behalf of the Band pursuant to Board Statute #1032-MLC-1, Section 21.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Board Statute #1032-MLC-1, Section 27, I, Joseph Nayquonabe do hereby approve the submittal of a P.L. 93-638 contract proposal to Indian Health Service to carry out the proposal project during the 12-month period beginning October 1, 1986, and ending September 30, 1987.
