- WHEREAS, the Non-Removal Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to execute and administer contracts pursuant to the provisions of Article VI, Section 1(c) of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, and;
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Indian Health Service (IHS) has funds to provide for medical, dental, alcohol, and;
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to provide for those services under the authority of a P.L. 93-638 (Indian Self-Determination Act) contract with IHS.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve the submittal of a P.L. 93-638 contract proposal to IHS to carry out the proposed project during the 12-month period beginning October 1, 1987, and ending September 30, 1988.
