**WHEREAS,** the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians have duly executed a intergovernmental agreement with the State of Minnesota to provide certain services in connection with a youth prevention project on the reservation, and;


**WHEREAS,** an intrinsic component of proper initial implementation of this contract is personnel selection, and;

**WHEREAS,** the Administration Policy Board has not processed a time table for personnel selection for this project, but has received applications/resumes of interested individuals, and;

**WHEREAS,** THE Commissioner of Human Services while on official travel status is unable to issue orders/or actions enacting a process to implement said contract, and with advice and assistance of the Commissioner of Administration, I hereby find authorization to issue this order.

**NOW THEREFORE,** pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25 I, Raymond Kegg, Assistant Commissioner of Administration and acting Commissioner of Human Services, do hereby order that Eloise Wind, Julie Shingobe and Sandra Churchill be hired as temporary outreach workers for the Youth Prevention Project for a period not exceeding 30 Calender days.
