

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER 08-86

HUMAN SERVICES

A Commissioner's Order authorizing the hiring of the Community Health Representative.

WHEREAS, the position of Community Health Representative, District I was posted in accordance with applicable sections to the personnel policies, and;

WHEREAS, the proper selection committee selected Debbie Mitchell to fill said position, and;

WHEREAS, the selection appears to lack any official documentation, and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Human Services in his physical absence from his official duties is unable to issue this order and authorized me, with his advice and consent, to issue this order.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 25, I, Raymond Kegg, Assistant Commissioner of Administration do hereby order that Debbie Mitchell be deemed an employee by virtue of a temporary hiring according to personnel policies and shall have all rights of a temporary employee.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that this order shall have a retro active effect from January 7, 1986 and shall continue to be in full force and effect until February 7, 1986.


