- WHEREAS, the Band is duly authorized to execute and administer contracts pursuant to the provisions of Article VI, Section 1(c) of the consittution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 21; and,
- WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has funds available to provide for medical and dental services; and,
- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa desires to provide for these services under the authority of P.L. 93.638 contract with Indian Health Service.
- WHEREAS, the Administrative Policy Board has been conferred subject-matter jurisdiction to authorize the preparation of proposals and to negotiate all grants and contracts on behalf of the Band pursuant to the Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 21.
- WHEREAS, the medical section of the Human Services Administration has identified further health care needs of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa.
- NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 27, I, Joseph Nayquonabe do hereby recommend the extension of contract 239-86-0015, to the Chief Executive and the Band Assembly, for the period from October 1, 1986 to November 30, 1986.
