COMMISSIONER'S ORDER NO. 65-87 Natural Resources

A Commissioner's Order to regulate the opening and closing of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa hunting seasons for the year 1987.

- WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has the power to open and close hunting seasons within the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa, through Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 29; and,
- WHEREAS, the Spiritual Advisor and the Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians concur that the seasons should be open; and,
- WHEREAS, the hunting of animals or birds should be done with preservation of the species foremost; and,
- NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, pursuant to Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 29, I, Don Wedll, Commissioner of Natural Resources, with the concurrence of the Spiritual Advisor, establish the following hunting season effective for the year 1987.
 - 1. Deer Bucks ONLY September 15, 1987 December 31, 1987

 Does/fawns October 17, 1987 December 31, 1987
 - 2. Ducks

 September 17, 1987 September 30, 1987

 Closed: October 1 October 3 (noon)

 Open: October 3, 1987 (noon) November 9, 1987
 - 3. Geese, Coots, Common Snipe, Woodcock, Rails

September 15, 1987 - October 2, 1987

Closed: October 2 (sunset) - October 3 (noon)

Open: October 3 (noon) - November 17, 1987

4. Mourning Doves Closed

5. Small game September 15, 1987 - December 31, 1987

These season dates are subjected to the Regulations established by Commissioner's Orders 53-87, 66-87 through 67-87, inclusive. This includes the number of species, areas open to hunting and method of taking games.
