COMMISSIONER ORDER 08-83 NATURAL RESOURCES

A Commissioner's Order accepting land in Crow Wing County for the purpose of a wildrice site located in the South half of Government Lot 2, Section 7, Township 135, Range 28.

WHEREAS:

The Commissioner of Natural Resources has the power to acquire land through gift, lease, or purchase, in the name of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa, through Band Statue 1028-MLC-1, Section 29: and

WHEREAS:

Harvey W. Richards and Marjorie P. Richards wish to donate, in the form of a gift, land located in the South half of Government Lot 2, Section 7, Township 135, Range 28: (See attached map) and

WHEREAS:

The said land is close to Clark Lake, a traditional ricing lake of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa: and

WHEREAS:

The said land is suitable for the purpose of a wild rice camp site and hunting area.

NOW THEREFORE, pusuant to the authority vested in me by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under Tribal law, I, Don Wedle, Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, hereby except the following land:

The South half of Government Lot 2, Section 1, Town-ship 135, Range 28 excepting reservation heretofore made of record, and excepting the North 241 feet of said lot, and excepting two acres deeded to Lester Larson and Martha Larson by dated September 28,1951 filed September 26,1951 in the office of the Register of Deeds, Crow Wing County, Minnesota in Book 138 of Deeds.

DATED at Vineland, Minnesota this ninth day of December in the year one thousand nine hundred and eighty three.
