

COMMISSIONER'S ORDER NO. 51-87  
Natural Resources

A Commissioner's Order amending Commissioner's Order No. 50-87, which established trapping regulations for 1986-87 Trapping Season, East of the St. Croix River for members of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

WHEREAS, Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 29 directs the Commissioner of Natural Resources to protect all natural resources of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner's Order No. 50-87 established the Off-Reservation 1986-87 Trapping Regulation, East of the St. Croix River for members of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians; and

WHEREAS, within said order, Section 307 subsection (0) was omitted.

NOW THEREFORE, by the authority vested in me by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under tribal law, I, Don Wedll, Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians hereby amend Commissioner's Order No. 50-87 to include the following Regulation.

Amendment

307. Methods - Snaring


a) No upland snare shall be set with a loop size greater than 10" in diameter.
