## COMMISSIONERS ORDER NO. 244-97 NATURAL RESOURCES

WHEREAS: the Commissioner of Natural Resources has the power to

regulate the opening and closing of season to take fish within the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians

through 11 MLBSA Section 2003; and

WHEREAS: the Spiritual Advisor and the Commissioner of Natural

Resources concur that the season and regulations for the

spearing of Me-zii (eelpout) should occur; and

WHEREAS: the taking of Me-zii by Band members will not have any

detrimental impact on the species; and

WHERÉAS: the taking of Me-zii is a traditional and cultural activity of the

Mille Lacs Chippewa; and

WHEREAS: the taking of Me-zii is done traditionally in late January and

February; and

WHEREAS: the taking of Me-zii was done to supplement the diet of Band

members, and

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Mille

Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under tribal law, I, Don Wedll, Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, hereby prescribe the following regulations applicable for the taking of Me-zii by taking off of particular

identified tribal lands.

## REGULATION License Requirement

- 1. Any Band member must have in their possession both an identification card and a valid Me-zii taking license.
- 2. No taking of Me-zii can be done in waters three feet deep (i.e. from the bottom of the lake to the bottom of the ice).
- 3. Only Me-zii are allowed to be taken by harpoon. No other species of fish may be taken by harpoon. A harpoon is defined as a singled tined lance or spear.
- 4. A daily limit of 30 (thirty) Me-zii may be taken by harpoon.
- 5. Taking of Me-zii will be limited to sunrise to sunset.
- 6. Me-zii season will open January 26 through February 15, 1990.
- 7. The hole size will not exceed a hole 2 square feet.

8. Area open to taking of Me-zii: Nay-ah-shing Point and Shaw-baush-kung Point, starting at the eastern most part of each point and running west along each side a distance of 1/4 of a mile. (see attached map).
