COMMISSIONER'S ORDER NO. 209-95 Natural Resources

A Commissioner's Order to regulate the opening and closing of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa hunting seasons for the year 1995.

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Natural Resources has the power to open and close hunting seasons within the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa through Band Statute 1162-MLC-50, Section 3; and,

WHEREAS, the Spiritual Advisor and the Commissioner of Natural Resources for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians concur that the seasons should be open; and,

WHEREAS, the hunting of animals or birds should be done with preservation of the species foremost; and,

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, pursuant to Band Statute 1162-MLC-50, Section 3, I, Don Wedll, Commissioner of Natural Resources, with the concurrence of the Spiritual Advisor, establish the following hunting seasons effective for the year of 1995.

SEASON DATES

1. Deer - Bucks ONLY September 15, 1995 - December 31, 1995 - Does/fawns October 22, 1995 - December 31, 1995

2. Ducks September 23, 1995-September 28, 1995
Closed: September (sunrise) 29 September 30 (noon)
Open:September 30, 1995 (noon)November 18, 1995

3. Geese, Coots, Common Snipe, Woodcock, Rails
September 15, 1995 - November 18,1995
Closed: September 29, (sunrise) September 30 (noon)
Open: September 30(noon) - November 18, 1995

4. Mourning Doves Closed

5. Small game September 15, 1995 - December 31, 1995

These season dates are subject to the Regulations established by Commissioner's Orders. This includes the number of species, areas of hunting and method of taking games.
