EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 012

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CEASING OPERATIONS OF THE
DRIFT INN RESTAURANT AND BAR DUE TO THE LACK
OF A PROPER LIQUOR LICENSE AND INADEQUATE
FINANCIAL RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 5, the Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to ensure the lawful operation of all activities within the Executive Branch of Tribal government,

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive is legally mandated to take care for the faithful execution of all laws and be responsible as custodian of all band property, and;

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive is empowered to take any such measures as are necessary to prevent any impending action which threatens the well-being of programs, legal system, natural resource, business and/or band members, and;

WHEREAS, the Secretary of Treasury is legally empowered under Section 6 of the above referenced statute to superintend and manage the fiscal concerns of the Band, as well as the power to attach any account of the Band for just cause.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and the Band Assembly of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under tribal law, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby order that all operations of the Drift Inn Restaurant and Bar managed by Leonard Sam hereby cease as of Monday, March 14, 1983.
