
**EXECUTIVE ORDER 100-94**

**An Executive Order Impounding the Tribal Court Car.**

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 7.05, the Chief Executive is authorized to issue Executive Orders on any subject matter within the Executive Branch pursuant to the authorities conferred by Band Statute; and,
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 7.06, the Chief Executive is authorized to act as the custodian for all Band property; and,
- WHEREAS,** a 1985 Oldsmobile sedan bearing Mille Lacs Tribal plate #5846 is operated by the tribal court for the stated purpose of aiding in the service of process; and,
- WHEREAS,** this vehicle is maintained with Band funds and is covered under the Band's vehicle insurance policy; and
- WHEREAS,** on the night of December 22, 1993, and on the morning of January 2, 1994, the tribal court vehicle was found in ditches; and,
- WHEREAS,** because the tribal court car was found in these ditches outside of normal working hours, it could not and was not being used for official court business; and
- WHEREAS,** the use of the tribal court car outside of the scope of court business constitutes a misuse of the vehicle and places Band property in jeopardy of being damaged or destroyed.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED** that the Tribal Police shall impound and hold the tribal court car until my further order. The Court of Central Jurisdiction shall turnover to the Tribal Police all sets of keys to this vehicle within 3 days of the date of this Executive Order.
