EXECUTIVE ORDER 101-92

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CREATING A TASK FORCE TO DEVELOP AN EFFECTIVE STATUTORY AND REGULATORY ADMINISTRATIVE SYSTEM FOR A HOUSING PROGRAM TO PROVIDE AFFORDABLE, QUALITY HOUSING FOR EVERY FAMILY OF THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to provisions of Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 7.07, the Chief Executive has the authority to appoint executive committees to assist in conducting the duties of the office;

WHEREAS, the lack of quality housing is among the most pressing needs on and near the Mille Lacs Reservation;

WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Band government to develop a housing program which will provide affordable quality housing to every Mille Lacs Band family; and

WHEREAS, in order to develop and execute such a program, the Band will need to create an effective and efficient statutory and regulatory administrative system for this program; and

WHEREAS, developing and executing the above mentioned program will require careful study and thoughtful recommendations by a task force comprised of community members and others knowledgeable in the area of housing and dedicated to the goal of providing affordable quality housing for all Mille Lacs Band families.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1142-MLC-3, Section 7.05, I, Margie Anderson, do hereby name and empower a task force to carefully study the current system of providing housing on the Mille Lacs Reservation and thoughtfully recommend ways to improve our system in such a manner as to provide affordable quality housing for every Mille Lacs Band family.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the task force be directed to carefully study the current statutory and regulatory scheme for the Housing Authority.

the current composition and function of the Housing Authority, the current staffing and administrative procedures of the Housing Authority, current methods of financing housing, and other pertinent factors regarding the provision of housing within the jurisdiction of the Mille Lacs Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the task force be directed to carefully recommend whatever changes the task force deems necessary to accomplish the goals of providing affordable quality housing for every Mille Lacs Band family.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the task force be comprised of Christine Costello, Geraldine Germann (Lake Lena) Dale Green (McGregor), David Boyd (Minnewawa), Leonard Sam and Arlene Weous (Vineland).

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the task force enter into a consultant agreement with Sam Griffin, Private Ventures Consultant, to assist the task force with their study and recommendation, and the cost of such an agreement to be paid from Band Assembly special appropriations.


BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that the task force be directed to present their recommendations to the Chief Executive no later than March 31, 1992.
