EXECUTIVE ORDER 149-05

**AN EXECUTIVE ORDER
PROHIBITING THE SALE OF MAGAZINES
THAT ENCOURAGE ILLEGAL DRUG USE OR PRODUCTION**

- WHEREAS,** pursuant to 4 MLBSA §6(e), the Chief Executive has the authority to issue Executive Orders on any subject matter within her jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS,** pursuant to 4 MLBSA §6(m), the Chief Executive has the authority to make rules and policies consistent with the provisions of Band statute; and
- WHEREAS,** it is fundamental to the continued integrity and strength of the Band that the use and production of illegal substances is not legitimized; and
- WHEREAS,** the production of methamphetamines should be adamantly discouraged; and
- WHEREAS,** the people of the Band should not be subjected to magazines that have the primary purpose of advocating the use and production of illegal substances.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that businesses located within the interior boundaries of the Mille Lacs Indian Reservation will adhere to the following two provisions:

1. All products that are commonly used in the production of methamphetamines shall be stored out of the main shopping area. If an excessive amount of these products is purchased, the Mille Lacs Band Tribal Police shall be notified of the purchase immediately.




2. No magazines will be sold that have a primary purpose of advocating the use, production or distribution of illegal substances such as, but not limited to "Weed World" or "High Times".
