GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 011

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER which authorizes a ninety day re-assignment for the Assistant Commissioner of Education Affairs and provides for the authority of an Assistant Superintendent during this period.

WHEREAS, Nay Ah Shing School is an officially recognized school of the Non-removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;

WHEREAS, Nay Ah Shing School needs to develop curriculum related to historical background of the Band as it relates to the rights, privileges, responsibilities and protections of the environment as related to the non-removable status of band members and to teach such curriculum to enrollees at the school, and;

WHEREAS, the Assistant Commissioner of Educational Affairs possesses the technical skills required to research the aforementioned issues and develop curriculum in this area.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians under tribal law, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby issue a temporary release of duties for a ninety day period of time for the Assistant Commissioner of Educational Affairs commencing March 1, 1983.

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that the Assistant Commissioner of Educational Affairs shall present a written report regarding all land issues of the Band with special reference to the determination of the non-removable status of the Band in light of the recent Voight decision in the 7th Circuit Court of Appeals. Additionally, he shall file a Class 1 designation with the federal Environmental Protection Agency which will protect the air and water source status on behalf of all Band members.

IT IS FINALLY PROCLAIMED that Mr. Lonnie Burr shall assume the day to day administration of all programs under the jurisdiction of Nay Ah Shing School with the title of Assistant Superintendent. The above said individual shall be authorized to represent the interests of Nay Ah Shing School before the School Board, Local Indian Education Committees, Educational Policy Board and the Office of Management and Budget. He shall not have authority to issue Commissioner's Orders or assume direction for the Education Policy Board.


