EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 016

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO WITHDRAW JURISDICTION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS AND PERSONNEL FROM THE ADMINISTRATION POLICY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the Administration Policy Board has been created and authorized to exercise the powers of the Executive Branch of tribal government as delegated by the Band Assembly through Band Statute 1008-MLC-1 as amended in Band Statute 1028-MLC-1; and,

WHEREAS, The Band Assembly has not enacted any legislation regarding the independence of law enforcement operations or personnel from the direct influence of elected or appointed officials of the Band; and,

WHEREAS, in the interests of unbiased and unprejudicial enforcement of all laws of the Band for the benefit of all those under the jurisdiction of the Band.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute and the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby transfer responsibility for day to day law enforcement operations and personnel to the Judicial Branch of tribal government.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that any duly sworn natural resource officer of the Band shall be deemed to possess authority to enforce all laws of the Non Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
