Executive Order 034

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO WITHDRAW ALL LEGAL AUTHORITY OF EVAN BURR, COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS AND FORMALLY ACCEPT HIS RESIGNATION.

- WHEREAS,** under the provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 5, Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to ensure the lawful operation of all activities under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS,** under provisions of Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 28, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs is empowered to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,
- WHEREAS,** the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs, Evan Burr has been absent without leave from his position since May 14, 1984 in gross neglect of his duties to the Band.
- NOW THEREFORE,** pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 2, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby withdraw all legal authority and accept the resignation of one, Evan Burr, Jr., as the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.
