EXECUTIVE ORDER 027

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER CEASING OPERATIONS AT THE DRIFT INN RESORT.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1028-MLC-1, Section 12, the Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to ensure the lawful operation of all activities under the jurisdiction of the Band, and;

WHEREAS, the Chief Executive is legally mandated to take care for the faithful execution of all laws and be responsible as custodian of all Band physical assets, and;

WHEREAS, the management agreement for the legal operation of the Drift Inn has expired on August 14, 1983 at 12:00 C.D.T. p.m. and continued operation from this date without legal authority violates the laws of the Mille Lacs Band.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 5.01, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby order the termination of all business activity under terms of a Management Agreement at the Drift Inn Resort immediately upon receipt of this order.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that Earl Inman conduct a physical inventory of all items to be concluded and returned by Friday, November 21, 1983 at 12:00 noon. Additionally, all cash and keys are to be returned to the Secretary of Treasury by November 15, 1983 at 5:00 p.m.
