Governmental Operations Executive Order 046

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO WITHDRAW ALL LEGAL AUTHORITY OF LEW BOYD, COMMISSIONER OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS AND FORMALLY ACCEPT HIS RESIGNATION.

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 5, the Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to ensure the lawful operation of all activities under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,

WHEREAS, under provisions of Band Statute 1032-MLC-1, Section 28, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs is empowered to administer, regulate and authorize all business enterprises under the jurisdiction of the Band; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs, Lew Boyd, has been absent without leave from his position since September 10, 1985, in gross neglect of his duties to the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1011-MLC-1, Section 2, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby withdraw all legal authority and accept the resignation of one Lew Boyd, as the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that the Commissioner of Administration is authorized to initiate the process of searching for a replacement for this open position and to formally notify the Band Assembly of the vacancy in the position of Commissioner of Corporate Affairs.
