Executive Order 051

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION OF JOSEPH NAYQUONABE, COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES AND TO APPOINT AN ACTING COMMISSIONER OF HUMAN SERVICES.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Band Statute 1024-MLC-1, Section 12, the Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to fill any vacancy that may occur in regard to his executive officers; and,

WHEREAS, on September 10, 1987, Joseph Nayquonabe, Commissioner of Human Services, submitted a letter of resignation to the Commissioner of Administration with said resignation effective immediately; and,

WHEREAS, without someone serving in the capacity of Commissioner of Human Services, many vital Human Service functions to eligible Band members may be jeopardized.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 2, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby accept the resignation of Joseph Nayquonabe as the Commissioner of Human Services for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED THAT, a temporary appointment not to exceed 30 (thirty) days be granted to Mabel Smith as Acting Commissioner of Human Services.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that the Commissioner of Administration is authorized to initiate the process of searching for a replacement for this vacant position.
