EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-02

Section 1. Purpose

This Executive Order rescinds Executive Order 033 and clarifies custodial authority over community centers in each District.

Section 2. Sources of Authority

The following statutory provisions serve as the basis for this Executive Order:

- (a) 4 MLBSA § 6(f) – The Chief Executive’s power and duty “[t]o act as the custodian of all Band property”; and
- (b) 4 MLBSA § 7(k) – Executive Officers shall “perform any duties as may be lawfully assigned by the Chief Executive.”

Section 3. Reassuming of Custodial Authority Over Community Centers

The Chief Executive rescinds Executive Order 033 and resumes custodial authority over community centers in each District.

Section 4. Administration and Use of Community Centers

The Chief Executive authorizes and directs the Commissioner of Administration to:


- (a) establish any necessary regulations, policies, and processes to govern the administration and fair use of community centers;
- (b) coordinate with the Commissioner of Human Services to develop regulations governing the safe use of community center facilities, equipment, and any other amenities that the Department of Health and Human Services will utilize for treatment of patients;


Section 5. Band Assembly

- (a) The Chief Executive directs the Commissioner of Administration to coordinate with:
 - (1) the Speaker of the Assembly to ensure accommodation for the conduct of Band Assembly sessions and public hearings; and
 - (2) each District Representative to ensure accommodation to meet with constituents and the performance of other legislative duties.
- (b) All Band Assembly sessions and public hearings and District Representative meetings with constituents will have priority use over any other conflicting scheduled events.

Section 6. Expiration

This Executive Order will remain effective until amended or rescinded by a subsequent statute or Executive Order.
