EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 019

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY FOSTER CARE LICENSURE TO MR. AND MRS. GEORGE AUBID FROM DISTRICT II-EAST LAKE FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED JULY 14, 1983 AT 12:00 C.D.T. P.M.

WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has jurisdiction to supervise the placement of enrolled members of the Band under provisions of the Indian Child Welfare Act 21 U.S.C. 1907, and;

WHEREAS, an enrolled member of the Band is in need of a suitable Indian foster home to which family ties have been established, and;

WHEREAS, said placement of the enrolled member is in the best interests of the member and the foster parents concerned are not licensed for foster care under provisions adopted by the then tribal governing body.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1001-MLC-1, Section 5 and the Article VI, Section 1(e) of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, I, Arthur Gahbow, do hereby order the issuance of an Emergency Temporary Foster Care License to Mr. & Mrs. George Aubid for a period not to exceed July 14, 1983 at 12:00 C.D.T. pm. During said time, application procedures for licensure shall be commenced by the Human Services Administration.
