EXECUTIVE ORDER 2025-03

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER RENAMING THE NEW DISTRICT 1 COMMUNITY CENTER

Section 1. Purpose and Policy.

The purpose of this Executive Order is to rename the District 1 community center, commonly known as the “New Community Center” or the “Aquatic and Fitness Center,” located at 18458 Minobimaadizi Loop, Onamia, MN 56359. It has been common practice of Chief Executives to name important governmental facilities after past leaders of the Band. Examples include the Biidaabanookwe Government Center, named after Chief Executive Marge Anderson; the Wewinabi Early Education Center, named after Chief Executive Art Gahbow; and the Meshakwad Community Center, named after Albert Churchill, Sr.

Section 2. Sources of Authority.

- a. Mille Lacs Band Statutes, Title 4, § 2 (Executive Political Authority), § 6(e) (Executive Orders), and § 6(f) (Custodian of Band Property).

Section 3. Miskwaanakwadookwe Community Center.

In honor of former District 1 Representative Sandra Blake, the community center, commonly known as the “New Community Center” or the “Aquatic and Fitness Center,” shall hereafter be referred to as the “Miskwaanakwadookwe Community Center.”

Section 4. Effectiveness.

This Executive Order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until superseded by statute or rescinded by subsequent Executive Order.
