Executive Order 030

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER TO SUPERSEDE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 041.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Band Statute 1028-MLC-1, Section 12, the Chief Executive is charged with the legal authority to ensure the laws of the Band are equally enforced for the benefit of all members; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Interior - Bureau of Indian Affairs has provided funding to the Natural Resource Department of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for the purpose of enforcing the laws, policies and judicial determinations of the Band and the provision of federal domestic assistance grants and contracts to the Band; and,

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Interior - Bureau of Indian Affairs requires a separation of Band enforcement units for natural resource protection laws and other criminal or civil laws enacted by the Band Assembly on behalf of the Non Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Band Statute 1028-MLC-1, Section 12, I, Arthur Gahbow do hereby transfer responsibility for the enforcement of all criminal and civil laws, executive, secretarial, legislative, and commissioners order and judicial determinations rendered by the Court of Central Jurisdiction from the Commissioner of Natural Resources to Russell James Bankey.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Russell James Bankey shall commence the performance of his legal duties under the title of 'Chief Law Enforcement Officer' in and for the Non Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians upon receiving the official oath of office.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Russell James Bankey shall maintain and keep in active status his Minnesota Peace Officers Standards and Training Board License No. 1391, which is valid until June 30, 1989.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the enforcement of the Natural Resource laws of the Non Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians shall remain vested under the jurisdiction of the Commissioner of Natural Resources.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that Russell James Bankey shall be bound by the provisions of Executive Order 030, dated at Vineland, Minnesota, the 1st day of December, 1983, regarding the firearms Discharge Policy of the Band.
