EXECUTIVE ORDER 106-92

An Executive Order establishing a federal and state political funds of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Mille Lacs Band Statute 1142-MLC-3 § 7.05, the Chief Executive has the authority to issue Executive Orders on any subject matter within the Executive Branch pursuant to the authorities conferred by Band Statute; and

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band has many vital interests to protect; and

WHEREAS, in several major areas where the Band has vital interests to protect there is a woeful lack of knowledge on these subject matters among the public as a whole, and the state and federal government in specific; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a state and federal political fund is one method of addressing such a woeful lack of knowledge, thereby protecting vital interests of the Band.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, that the Chief Executive hereby establishes a state political fund to be named Mah Mah Wi No Min - I, and a federal political fund to be named Mah Mah Wi No Min - II.

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that Doug Twait, Corporate Commissioner shall serve as the Chair of these political funds, and Melanie Benjamin, Commissioner of Administration shall serve as treasurer of these political funds.


BE IT FURTHER ORDERED, that the Commissioner of Finance is directed to take all steps necessary and proper to establish bank accounts for these political funds.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY ORDERED, that the Band transfer \$20,000.00 for the General Band Account to the Mah Mah Wi No Min - I Fund and from the General Band Account to the Mah Mah Wi No Min - II Fund as the initial capitalization of these two funds.
