Legislative Order 013

- Whereas, the Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe Indians; and,
- Whereas, the Band Assembly is responsible for appropriating all funds of the Band pursuant to the provisions of Band Statute 1141-MLC-2, Sec. 5, and,
- Whereas, the Band Assembly unanimously approved Band Assembly Bill 06-02-04-95 entitled "Revised Chapter 4 Judicial Code" (Band Statute 1303-MLC-4) in a regular session of the Band Assembly on April 19, 1995; and,
- Whereas, the Court of Central Jurisdiction has taken the position that certain provisions of Band Statute 1303-MLC-4 regarding budgetary appropriations and salary levels for the remainder of FY-95 are ambiguous.

NOW BE IT ORDERED, pursuant to the powers vested in the Band Assembly by Article VI of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Band Statute 1141-MLC-2, Sec. 28, the following Legislative Order shall apply to Band Statute 1303 MLC-4.

Rule 1

The budgetary provisions of the Band Statute 1303-MLC-4, Sec. 18, which provides that the Band Assembly shall establish salaries for the Justices of the Court of Central Jurisdiction shall be effective May 29, 1995.

Rule 2

The current workload of the Court is not sufficient to justify full-time equivalency (FTE) classifications for the Justices of the Court of Central Jurisdiction, therefore salaries for the Associate Justices and the Chief Justice are as follows:

These amounts shall be prorated and paid on a weekly basis.

Rule 3




