LEGISLATIVE ORDER No. 023

**A LEGISLATIVE ORDER REQUIRING ALL EMPLOYEES
OF THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH TO WORK A FOUR (4) HOUR SHIFT
DURING THE ANNUAL AUGUST POWWOW IN ORDER
TO EARN MILLE LACS DAY HOLIDAY PAY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA sec. 1, all legislative political authority of the Mille Lacs Band of Ojibwe is vested in the Legislative Branch of government; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 3 MLBSA sec. 27(a) the Band Assembly may issue Legislative Orders on any subject matter within the Legislative Branch of government pursuant to authority conferred by this Title and the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this authority as herein stated above, the Band Assembly hereby requires that all employees of the Legislative Branch work a four (4) hour shift during the annual August powwow in order to earn the Mille Lacs Day Holiday pay.

NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDERED THAT all employees employed under the Legislative Branch shall be required to work a four (4) hour shift during the annual August powwow in order to earn the Mille Lacs Day Holiday pay.
