LEGISLATIVE ORDER 008

WHEREAS, The Band Assembly is deeply concerned about the imminent termination of the Solicitor General on April 30, 1987, without the nomination of an officer by the Chief Executive to succeed the Solicitor General or the re-appointment of the Solicitor General, and;

WHEREAS, The Band Assembly will adjourn its legislative session on Wednesday, April 29, 1987 until the second Tuesday in July, 1987 according to its rule, and;

WHEREAS, The lack of the name of a qualified person to act as Solicitor General creates a vacuum and the Band Assembly has a duty to see to it that a key officer is available to the Band government, and;

WHEREAS, The Band Assembly finds an emergency exists to justify an extension of the term of the Solicitor General for a period of ninety-two (92) days, until July 31, 1987, so as to preserve the services of the Solicitor General to the Band because they are urgently needed for the fulfillment of the legal obligations of the Band.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authorities vested in the Band Assembly by Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, it is hereby ordered that the term of the Solicitor General is hereby extended through July 31, 1987.
