LEGISLATIVE ORDER 010

- WHEREAS, The Chief Executive is empowered with the authority to nominate and forward to the Band Assembly for confirmation the name(s) of competent and duly qualified individual(s) of high honor and integrity to serve in key positions of the government of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians, and;
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly finds that the lack of timely nominations by the Chief Executive of competent and duly qualified individual(s) to serve as key officer(s) of the Band government prior to the official date of expiration of the term creates a governmental vacuum which restricts the normal course of governmental function, and;
- WHEREAS, To allow for the continued normal functions of the Band government and to prevent disorder or paralysis of normal governmental functions, it is incumbent on the Band Assembly to issue this Legislative Order, due to the absence of controlling language on this subject in the Band Statutes 1001-MLC-1 and 1024-MLC-3, and;
- WHEREAS, The Band Assembly and the Court of Central Jurisdiction are deeply concerned about the lack of a nomination from the Chief Executive for the statutory position of Solicitor General.


NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authorities vested in the Band Assembly by Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, it is hereby ordered that all elected and appointed officials in and for the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians shall remain in office until such time as their successors are duly elected and sworn to the official oath of office or nominated by the Chief Executive duly confirmed by the Band Assembly and sworn to the official oath of office; unless, the officer resigns or is subject to disciplinary or removal proceedings pursuant to Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, Section 20 or specific provisions of Band Statute supercede this order, or the statutes of the Band are amended pursuant to Band law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Jay Kanassatega is and shall continue to be the duly qualified Solicitor General in and for the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians until such time as the Chief Executive nominates' a competent and duly qualified individual of high honor and integrity to be Solicitor General and the Band Assembly confirms said nominee and he/she is administered the official oath of office.


IT IS FINALLY ORDERED, that Legislative Order 008, dated April 29, 1987 is hereby superceded in all things.


