



# MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA INDIANS

## LEGISLATIVE ORDER 011

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is authorized to administer any funds of the Band for public purposes pursuant to Article VI, Section 1 (b) of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly hereby amends and modifies Legislative Order 007, and;

WHEREAS, the Band Assembly hereby designates Rural American Bank of Isle, Minnesota as the depository for governmental funds of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians until such time as this legislative order is rescinded or modified and said written order is received by the said designated Bank; and,

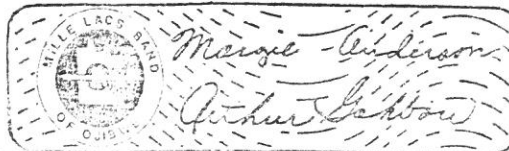
WHEREAS, it is necessary to specify the terms and conditions applicable for the creation of a financial trust relationship between the Band and Rural American Bank.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authorities vested in the Band Assembly by Article IV of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and Band Statute 1141-MLC-2, it is hereby ordered that Rural American Bank of Isle, Minnesota is designated as the depository for governmental funds of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians subject to restrictions imposed by the laws of the United States of America and the Mille Lacs Band.

Pursuant to Band Statute 1141-MLC-2 and 1142-MLC-3 Marge Anderson, the Secretary-Treasurer and Arthur Gahbow, Chief Executive, or their designees, are representatives of the Mille Lacs Band to transact financial affairs on behalf of the Band with Rural American Bank.

The designated representatives of the Mille Lacs Band are authorized to:

1. Open any deposit or checking account(s) in the name "Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians".
2. Endorse checks and orders for the payment of money and withdraw funds on deposit with Rural American Bank of Isle, Minnesota.
3. The signatures or facsimile of signatures of Marge Anderson and Arthur Gahbow as illustrated below are both required to transact financial affairs of the Mille Lacs Band as herein authorized:

4. Present to Rural American Bank of Isle, Minnesota any official enactments of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians which serve to govern the operation of the public funds of the Mille Lacs Band as exercised by the designated representatives of the Band.
5. Negotiate the terms and conditions of any account agreement properly opened by the designated representatives, subject to ratification by the Band Assembly.
6. All public governmental funds of the Band which are on deposit at Rural American Bank are hereby declared to be trust funds obtained either from the United States of America, the State of Minnesota or the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians subject to restrictions against alienation by any party and obligated for the general welfare of the members of the Band consistent with the purposes for which the funds were obligated.
7. The laws of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians and the United States of America govern the funds on deposit at Rural American Bank.
