## RESOLUTION 152-77

WHEREAS, many enrolled members are applying for assistance within the State and will require a 25 year lease, with option to renew for a like period, and

WHEREAS, a tribal resolution is needed to approve said lease, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee meets too infrequently to make said approval and delays the program excessively.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee delegates said approval to the President and Secretary of the Tribal Executive Committee for tracts not in excess of one(1) acre and the Bureau of Indian Affairs is directed to proceed with transactions on that basis.

We do hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted by a vote of 9 for 0 against, at a Special meeting of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribal Executive Committee, a quorum being present, held on March 10, 1977, at White Earth, Minnesota.
