RESOLUTION 10-83 A

A CONTINUING RESOLUTION FOR THE MILLE LACS BAND OF CHIPPEWA
P.L. 93-638 NATURAL RESOURCES PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has a responsibility to fund tribes in their efforts to develop their self-determination efforts through P.L. 93-638 Indian Self-Determination Act, and;


WHEREAS, the tribal government of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians desires to continue, monitor and expand its Natural Resources program, and;

WHEREAS, the protection of all matters relating to land, air, water, and the environment are of the highest priority for Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does hereby approve and adopt the continuation of the P.L. 93-638 Natural Resource Program for the Mille Lacs Reservation and that this resolution will remain in effect until rescinded.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, the foregoing Resolution No. 10-83 A was duly adopted at a special meeting of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa, a quorum being present, held on Monday the seventh day of March in the year of one thousand, nine hundred and eighty-three, at Vineland, Minnesota, by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
