RESOLUTION C5-83

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians is a sovereignty possessed of the jurisdiction and authority to exercise regulatory control within the territorial boundaries of the Band, and;
- WHEREAS, The government for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has the authority to acquire lands by virtue of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, and;
- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians has acquired a tract of land described as the North Half (N1) of Outlot Four (4), Isle Harbor Townsite, Village of Isle, from Mr. Frank Sam and Batiste Sam, his wife, and;
- WHEREAS, This property should now be placed in trust; for the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians for Housing, Economic Development, and to further self-determination, so
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee does hereby request that the Bureau of Indian Affairs complete the steps necessary to process the above-described lands into trust status.
