RESOLUTION 41-83

A RESOLUTION OF COMPLAINT AS THE FORMAL CHARGES FOR  
IMPEACHMENT OF THE DISTRICT II REPRESENTATIVE, JULIE  
F. SHINGOBE.

WHEREAS, The District II Representative was formally CENSURED on  
September 1, 1983 through Resolution 38-83 for dereliction  
and neglect of duty and refusal to comply with provisions  
of Article XIII of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa  
Tribe; and,

WHEREAS, the District II Representative consented to the request of the  
Speaker of the Assembly on Wednesday, September 14, 1983 to  
come before the Band Assembly on Monday, September 19, 1983  
with a petition of confidence from the resident eligible voters  
of District II; and,

WHEREAS, the District II Representative has failed to comply with the agree-  
ment to attend the formal session of the Band Assembly held on  
Monday, September 19, 1983 and answer the formal CENSURE of the  
joint session of the Band Assembly; and,

WHEREAS, the absence of the District II Representative has rendered the  
Legislative Branch of Tribal Government inoperative thus causing  
severe legal, economic and social difficulties which resulted in  
a state of emergency for the people who comprise the Mille Lacs  
Band of Chippewa Indians.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Speaker of the Band Assembly is hereby  
authorized to present to the Solicitor General of the Band the follow-  
ing charges of impeachment of Julie F. Shingobe, District II  
Representative.

### FORMAL CHARGES OF IMPEACHMENT

1. Julie F. Shingobe, District II Representative to the  
Band Assembly is hereby charged with dereliction and  
neglect of duty.
2. Julie F. Shingobe, District II Representative to the  
Band Assembly is hereby charged with the refusal to  
comply with Article XIII provisions of the Constitution  
of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe and the statutes of the  
Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians as stated in the  
official oath of office.

BE IT FURTHER AND FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Solicitor General is hereby authorized to prepare a formal complaint of impeachment and to represent the interests of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians as promulgated in Band Statute 1024-MLC-3, Section 19.

In accordance with Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, Section 20, we, the popularly elected officials of tribal government for the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians do hereby affix our signatures to this RESOLUTION OF COMPLAINT which was duly adopted at a special session of the joint Executive and Legislative branches of government held on Thursday, September 22, 1983 at Vineland, Minnesota.
