## RESOLUTION 34-83

A RESOLUTION PERTAINING TO THE REHABILITATION OF HOUSES ON THE MILLE LACS RESERVATION UNDER THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT, H.U.D. FOR FISCAL YEAR 1983 - 84

- WHEREAS, it is the continuing effort and desire of the Mille Lacs Band Assembly to promote Economic, Health and Social Development of the Non-Removable Band of Chippewa Indians and
- WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians to provide a top priority for FY 83 1984 in Housing Rehabilitation for the residents of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians and
- WHEREAS, a list of priorities has been established to be considered in the selection of houses and rehabilitation and
- WHEREAS, a rehabilitation is to be done on houses of permanent nonseasonal Residents of low income status to bring houses up to Reservation code and to eliminate health and safety hazards.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislatures being present, held on August 8, 1983 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
