## RESOLUTION D2-83

- WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee desires to exercise it's Self-Determination options, and
- WHEREAS, Public Law 93-638 authorizes tribal organization to plan, conduct and administer program administered by the Bureau of Indian Affairs,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee requests to negotiate a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to plan, conduct, and administer financial assistance to meet the specialized and unique educational needs of eligible Indian students served by the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, commonly called the Johnson O'Malley Program,

## BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that,

- {l} The Chairman {Executive Officer} of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments there to.
- {2} The authorities granted by this resolution shall be effective until rescinded by the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee.
- {3} The proposed date for contract commencement shall be October, 1983 for the 1984 fiscal year and each and every year thereafter, or until the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee rescinds this resolution.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee requests technical assistance from the Bureau of Indian Affairs in preparing the necessary documents to fulfill the initial contracting request.

We do hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was duly presented and enacted upon by a vote of 3 for 0 against 0 silent at a special meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee a quorum being present held on February 7, 1983, at Vineland Minnesota.
