### RESOLUTION 38-83

A RESOLUTION OF CENSURE OF THE DISTRICT II REPRESENTATIVE, JULIE F. SHINGOBE, FOR DERELICTION AND NEGLECT OF DUTY AND REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE XIII OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE MINNESOTA CHIPPEWA TRIBE.

WHEREAS, the District II Representative has failed to attend legal sessions of the Band Assembly held on Monday, August 29, 1983 and Tuesday, August 30, 1983, and;

WHEREAS, the Speaker of the Assembly legally authorized the convening of the Band Assembly pursuant to his statutory authority in Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, Section 8, and;

WHEREAS, the absences of the District II Representative has prohibited the necessary continuation of normal governmental activity by the Legislative branch of tribal government during the existence of an emergency situation related to the agreement between the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the District II Representative is hereby CENSURED for dereliction and neglect of her official duties and her refusal through default to abide by Article XIII of the Constitution of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.

In accordance with Band Statute 1002-MLC-2, Section 8, we, the popularly elected officials of tribal government for the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians do hereby affix our signatures to this Censure Resolution which was duly adopted at a special session of the joint executive and legislative branches of government held on Thursday, September 1, 1983 at Vineland, Minnesota.
