WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority has received additional HUD Homes, and

WHEREAS, These HUD Homes must have sites assigned by Lease to the Mille Lacs Housing Authority, and


WHEREAS, These sites are described as:

- Site 2, District 3 Within ML-197 & 201 SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
- Site 3, District 3 Within ML-199 & 202 SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
- Site 3-A, District 3 Within ML-199 & 202 SE $\frac{1}{2}$ sec 3 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
- Site 4 District 3 Within ML-258 SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec 2 T. 41 N., R. 17 W.
- Site 5 District 3 Within ML-258 & 189 Sec 2 T. 41 N., R. 17 W., and

WHEREAS, The attachment to this Resolution does contain the entire Metes and Bounds descriptions as written within the certificates of Survey, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the above described property be leased to the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority for a period of 25 years plus 25 years, at no cost, and further requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs approve the above mentioned leases.
