WHEREAS, the purpose of the Nay Ah Shing Special Education and Handicapped Proposal is to provide Nay Ah Shing students with career guidance in college preparation, and;


WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Band Council is the grantee for the Nay Ah Shing School.
