HEREAS, The attachment to this resolution does contain the entire Metes and Bounds descriptions as written within the Certificates of Survey, and

AND WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee hereby approves the above described property be leased to the Mille Lacs Reservation Housing Authority for a period of 25 years plus 25 years, at no cost, and further requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs approve the above mentioned leases.
