A CONTINUING RESOLUTION FOR 93-638 FUTURE CONTRACTS  
RESOLUTION NO. 18A

WHEREAS; Public Law 93-739 states in part, "to provide maximum Indian participation in the government and education of Indian people; to provide for full participation of Indian tribes in programs and services conducted by the federal government for Indians and to encourage the development of Human Resources of the Indian people", and,

WHEREAS; The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is a federally recognized tribe under provision of the 1934 Indian Reorganization Act with a corporate charter issued 1934, and,

WHEREAS; The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is delegated authority to contract for development projects, and,

WHEREAS; The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee deems acquisition of contracts to serve its constituency a top priority in terms of tribal sovereignty and service responsibility jurisdiction,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee does request a continuation of 93-638 for future water and sewer contracts.

WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, the foregoing Resolution No. 18A, was duly adopted at a special meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, a quorum being present held on \_\_\_\_\_, the 26 day of APRIL, in the year of one thousand, nine hundred and eighty-three, at Vineland, Minnesota, by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
