RESOLUTION NO. 21

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee is the governing body of the Mille Lacs Reservation and;

WHEREAS, The Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has assumed Land Management by virtue of the Land Ordinance No. 2 passed by Tribal Executive Committee on October 22 and 23, 1980, and;

WHEREAS, [REDACTED] is a member of Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa and has requested a homesite.

WHEREAS, The homesite requested is described as: Lot 6, Block 1, as defined by Vineland Hills Map as part of the N 1/2 NE 1/4, Section 28, TWP 43 N, Range 27 W.

WHEREAS, This lease will be for 25 years plus 25 years, at no cost with the effective date retroactive to September 5, 1979.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee hereby approves a Homesite Lease for [REDACTED] for a period of 25 years plus 25 years at no cost and the effective date of this lease will be [REDACTED] and the Homesite will be at the above described property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bureau of Indian Affairs is requested to approve the above described lease.
