RESOLUTION NO. 37-83

A RESOLUTION GRANTING THE RELINQUISHMENT OF ROBERT MARTIN HOULE, JR. AS A MEMBER OF THE MILLE LACS BAND, MILLE LACS RESERVATION.

- WHEREAS, the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee has screened the following application for relinquishment, and;
- WHEREAS, Robert Martin Houle, Jr. has signed a relinquishment form with the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe as he relinquishes and surrenders any and all rights, title and interest that he may have in any undistributed property or assets of the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe, and;
- WHEREAS, information received by the Turtle Mountain Agency states their Tribal Council will accept Robert Martin Houle, Jr. for membership providing that relinquishment is certified by the Minnesota Chippewa Tribe.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee does determine that this relinquishment is proper and that the interest of the individual has been considered and that he does meet the requirements for membership with the Turtle Mountain Band of Chippewa Indians, and does approve the granting of the relinquishment for Robert Martin Houle, Jr.
- We, do hereby certify, the foregoing Resolution No. 37-83 was duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Mille Lacs Reservation Business Committee, a quorum being present held on Monday, the eighth day of August in the year one thousand nine hundred and eighty three, at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, 0 silent.
