RESOLUTION 33

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A CONTRACT WITH THE BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS FOR FUNDS TO BE USED FOR FISHERIES AND FOREST MANAGEMENT.

- WHEREAS: The Mille Lacs Band Assembly is the duly elected governing body of the Non-Removable Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians and:
- WHEREAS, it is among the highest priority of the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians to develop and implement sound natural resource practices:
- WHEREAS: the Bureau of Indian Affairs has \$25,000.00 and \$5,900.00 of contract funds available for fisheries and forest management.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians requests to contract these programs from the Bureau of Indian Affairs. However, the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians does not accept trust responsibility by the virtue of this contract under appropriate sections of Public Law 93-638.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mille Lacs Band of Chippewa Indians retains the right to retrocede this contract to the Bureau of Indian Affairs, for cause, at any time.
- WE DO HEREBY CERTIFY, that the foregoing resolution was duly concurred with and adopted at a formal session of the Band Assembly in Legislative Council assembled, a quorum of legislatures being present, held on August 3, 1983 at Vineland, Minnesota by a vote of 3 for, 0 against, and 0 silent.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, we the Administrative Policy Board, hereunto recommend the signature of the Chief Executive to be affixed to this resolution.
